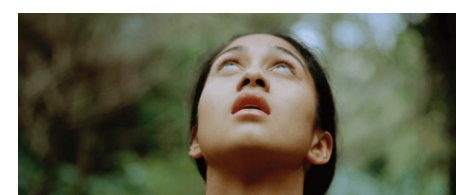
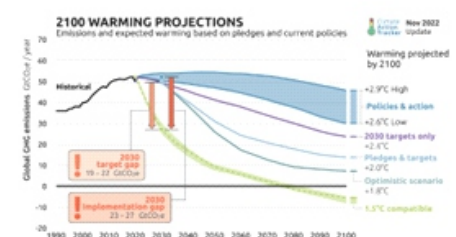
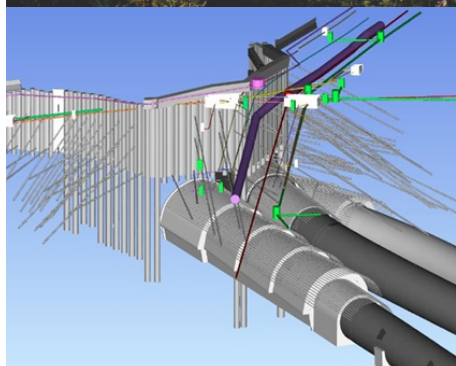


Extension of Time for Abstracts Submission AUSTRALASIAN TUNNELLING CONFERENCE
